### New proposals

The Negotiating Team met with the Employer Party on Tuesday, November 10. The employer party indicated that they might be withdrawing some of their demands.

But there is no movement with regard to our own union demands and, at this point, only one of our demands has been accepted.

At the end of the meeting, however, the Employer Party announced that they would present us with a new comprehensive proposal before the end of the week, which “should bring us closer to a settlement.”

They will give us the new proposal on Friday morning and we are hoping that it will not be as contemptuous and odious as the one we were given on September 22 and that the CPNC will accept some of our union demands.

### Your mobilization affected the employer

The strike days held so far have had an effect at the negotiating tables. At the central table, new wage offers last Friday from the Treasury Board, though meager and insufficient, are a move in the right direction. Negotiations continue and our Common Front representatives are doing everything they can to get the government to improve their offers. We believe that the movement we saw from the Employer Party this

week will be reflected in the proposal we will receive on Friday. There is no doubt that the pressure exerted by FPSES members has produced results. We can't give up now!

We need to increase the pressure and force the government and the CPNC to act in order to hold onto our rights and, above all, improve our working conditions.

Thank you for joining us on the picket lines, your energy is contagious and we appreciate your commitment and are proud to represent you.
